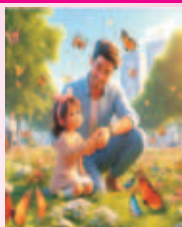
My father works hard day & night,

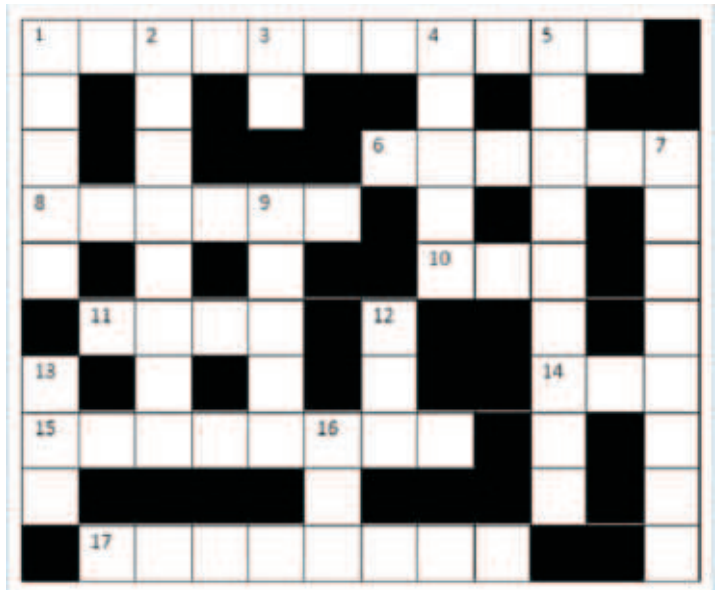

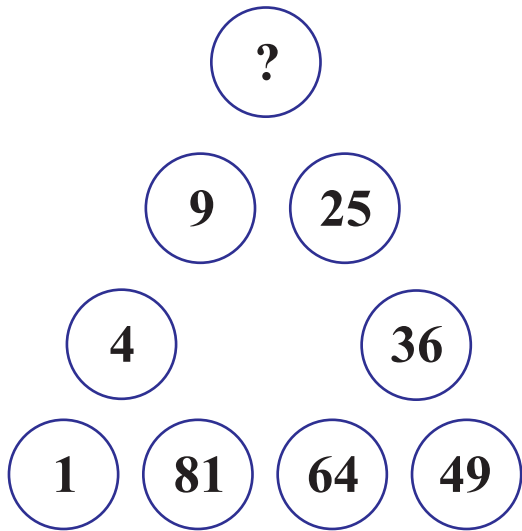
